



## Arts in California Parks, Grants Program Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Before applying, review the following minimum qualifications to ensure your organization and project are eligible for funding.

## Who Can Apply?

Completed applications must be submitted by one of the following eligible entities:

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations
- Fiscally sponsored community organizations
- California Native American tribes
- Native 7871 organizations
- Foundations
- Land trusts
- Local government agencies (city, county, or regional\*)

\*Regional agencies refer to government entities operating across multiple jurisdictions, such as regional park districts, regional planning agencies, or multi-county collaborations.

## **Partnership Requirement**

Projects must involve a collaborative partnership between:

- Nonprofit(s)
- Local public park manager(s)

Eligible partners may include nonprofit organizations, fiscally sponsored community organizations, California Native American tribes, Native 7871 organizations, foundations, land trusts, and/or local government agencies.

## **Project Requirements**

- Projects must integrate art and nature as a catalyst for community connection in local parks.
- Projects must be free and open to the public.
