



Arts in California Parks, Grants Program **Minimum Eligibility Requirements**

Before applying, review the following minimum qualifications to ensure your organization and project are eligible for funding. Applicants will complete an initial eligibility questionnaire to confirm that your organization meets all the minimum requirements to apply for this grant

Who Can Apply?

Completed applications must be submitted by one of the following eligible entities:

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations
- Fiscally sponsored community organizations
- California Native American tribes
- Native 7871 organizations
- Foundations
- Land trusts
- Local government agencies (city, county, or regional*)

**Regional agencies refer to government entities operating across multiple jurisdictions, such as regional park districts, regional planning agencies, or multi-county collaborations.*

Partnership Requirement

Projects must involve a collaborative partnership between:

- Nonprofit(s)
- Local public park manager(s)

Eligible partners may include nonprofit organizations, fiscally sponsored community organizations, California Native American tribes, Native 7871 organizations, foundations, land trusts, and/or local government agencies.

Project Requirements

- Projects must integrate art and nature as a catalyst for community connection in local parks.
- Projects must be free and open to the public.
